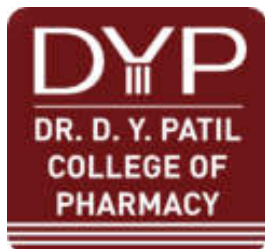

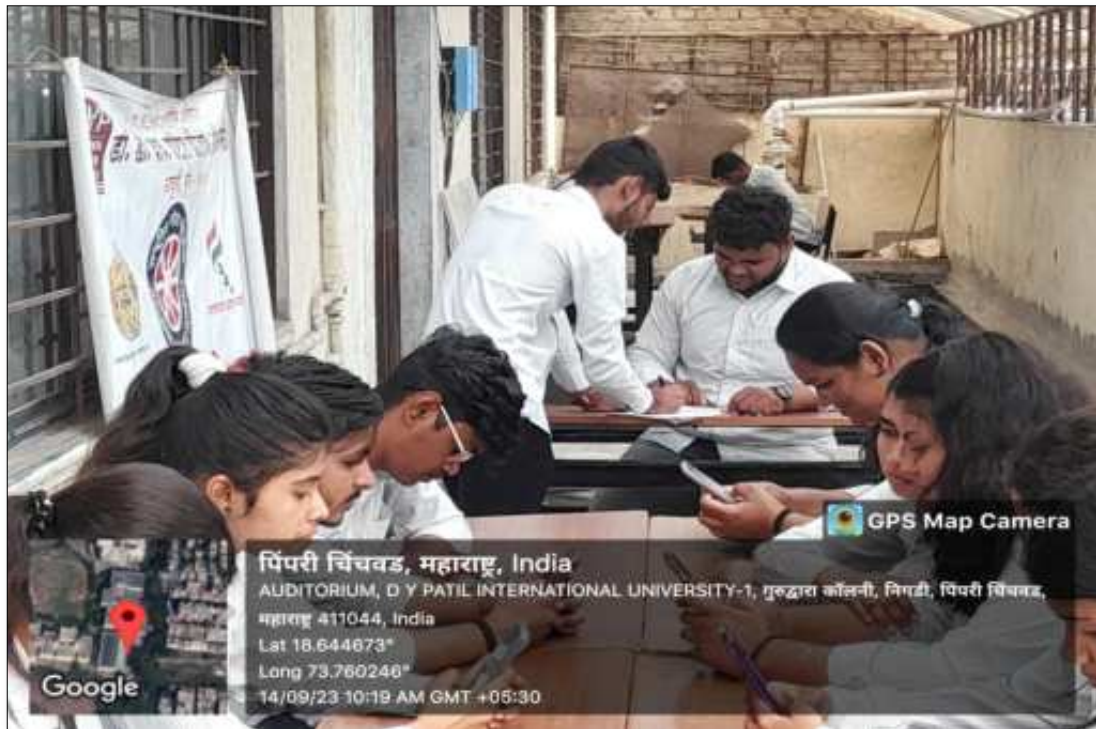

Dr. Avinash Bhondve delivered a session on “**Pharmacist as a scientist.**” In which he explained how Pharmacists play a crucial role in the healthcare system and can indeed be considered scientists. Here are the several points he mentioned.

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1. **Education and Training:** Pharmacists undergo extensive education and training in the pharmaceutical sciences. They typically earn a Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.), Master of Pharmacy (M pharm) and PhD degrees, which includes coursework in pharmacology, medicinal chemistry, pharmaceuticals, pharmacokinetics, pharmacotherapy, and other related disciplines. This scientific education equips pharmacists with the knowledge and skills needed to understand the mechanisms of action of drugs, their interactions with the human body, and their therapeutic effects including Drug Discovery and Developments.
2. **Medication Management and Optimization:** Pharmacists are experts in medication management and optimization. They collaborate with healthcare providers to ensure that patients receive the most appropriate and effective treatments based on scientific evidence, patient-specific factors, and therapeutic guidelines. Pharmacists also play a key role in monitoring for drug interactions, adverse effects, and medication adherence, thereby optimizing patient outcomes.
3. **Clinical Research and Evidence-Based Practice:** Many pharmacists are involved in clinical research and contribute to the generation of new scientific knowledge in the field of pharmacy and pharmacotherapy. They conduct studies, analyse data, and disseminate findings through publications and presentations. Pharmacists also adhere to the principles of evidence-based practice, incorporating the best available evidence from scientific research into their decision-making process when caring for patients.

The students were briefed about the session followed by the felicitation of our chief guest and trainer Ms. Kshitija Parjane. After the introduction, there was a session on confidence boosting. Do's and don'ts of public speaking along with tips and tricks for imbining confidence in oneself were discussed. Post lunch break, an interesting activity was conducted for demonstrating team-leadership and co-ordination. This activity emphasized on the importance of non-verbal as well as verbal communication. On day 2, soft skill development was discussed

. The importance of soft skill development and methods to achieve the same were demonstrated. An elaborate question-answer session was also conducted The students were also asked to fill out the forms for SWOT (Strength, Weakness, Opportunities, Threats) analysis for themselves individually. This helped the students in identification of their abilities and scope of improvements as well as assisted them for setting personal and professional goals. 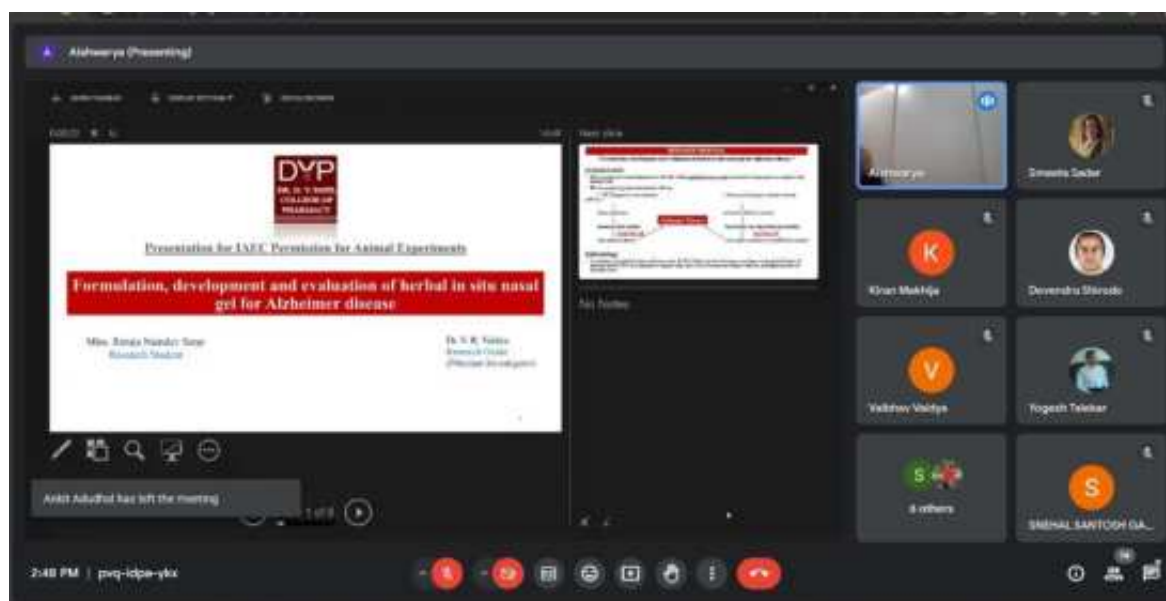

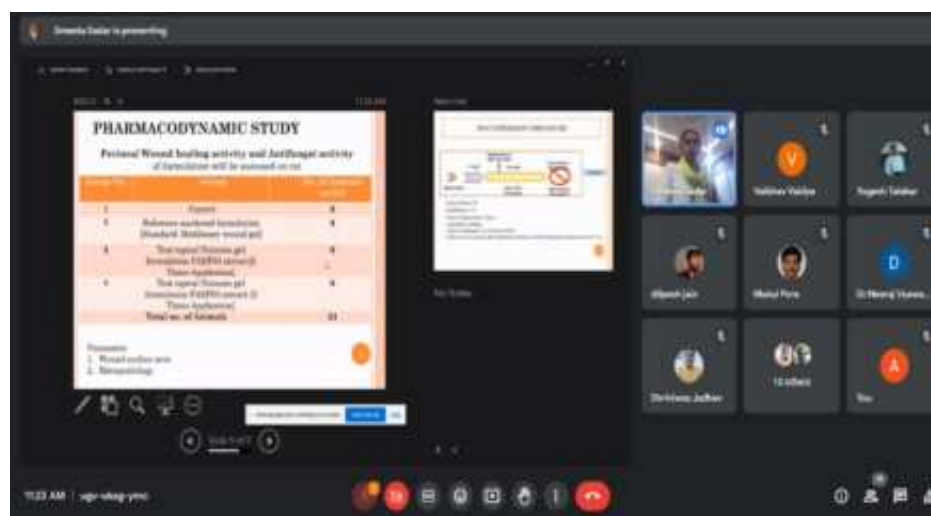
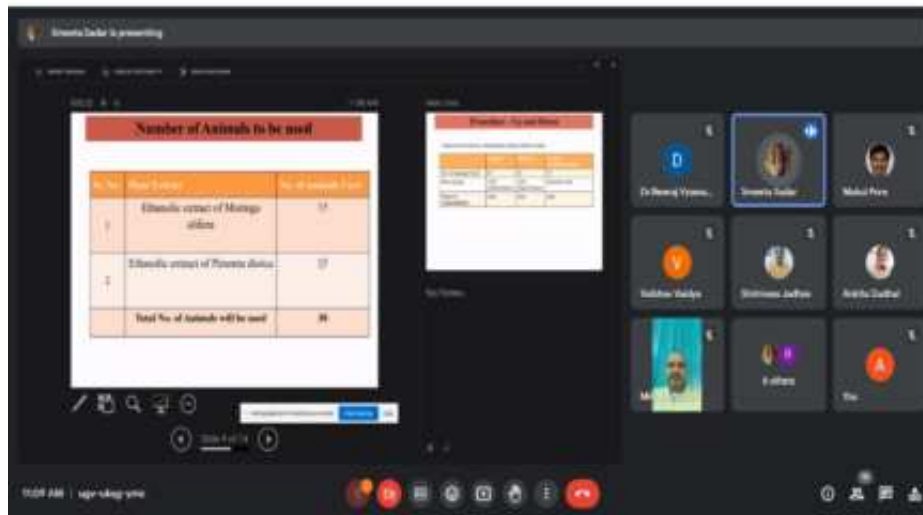
