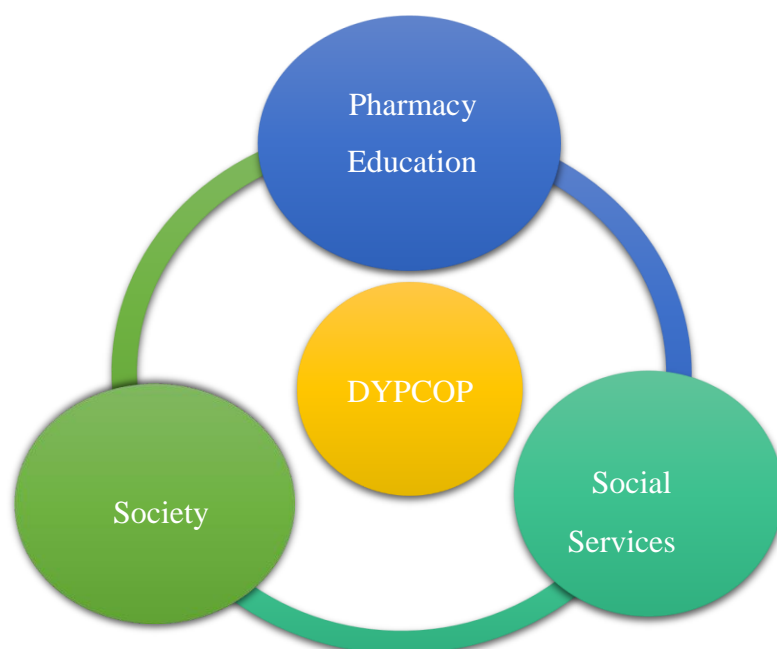

Dr. D. Y. Patil College of Pharmacy (DYPCOP) encourages its students to develop a deep sense of social responsibility, emphasizing the importance of "giving back to society" as future pharmacists. The college fosters this through a variety of activities that integrate pharmacy education with community service, helping students become ethical, well-rounded professionals. Some of the notable initiatives are:

- 1. Distribution of Medicine to Police and Pilgrims (War Kari):** The people who participate in the Wari are called **War Karis**, which means "one who performs the Wari". They undertake the journey, which involves walking long distances, often for several days. The War Karis typically travel in large groups, chanting devotional songs, and singing hymns in praise of Vithoba. Every year, students and faculty of DY Patil College of Pharmacy (DYPCOP) actively contribute to the Pandharpur Wari by providing invaluable medical support to the pilgrims. As part of their community service initiative, they distribute free medicines to the devotees participating in the religious pilgrimage, ensuring that they have access to essential healthcare during their long journey. Additionally, DYPCOP students and staff offer medical aid to both the pilgrims and the police officers involved in the event, helping to address any health concerns or emergencies that may arise during the procession.
- 2. Distribution of Books to Snehwan:** Snehwan is a non-profit organization founded by Ashok Deshmane in December 2015, located near Alandi, Pune. The organization's primary mission is to provide a nurturing and inclusive learning environment for the less fortunate children, particularly those from farming and impoverished families. DYPCOP students distribute books, pens, and notebooks to underprivileged children, funded by voluntary donations from students and faculty, to promote the importance of education. DYPCOP students give guidance about 'Good food Good life' to the children.

- 3. Visit to Paraplegic Rehab Centre (PRC):** The Paraplegic Rehabilitation Centre (PRC) is located in Range Hills, Kirkee, Pune, and is a prominent facility specializing in the rehabilitation of defense personnel who have sustained spinal cord injuries while serving the nation. The primary goal of the center is to offer comprehensive aftercare and rehabilitation services to Indian Armed Forces personnel who have been medically discharged. Students and faculty regularly visit in each year this center, which supports soldiers suffering from spinal cord injuries. They provide health advice, counsel on medication use, and offer other forms of support.
- 4. Visit to Old Age Home 'Sneh Sawali-Aple Ghar':** Students and faculty visit elderly people in old age homes to offer medical guidance, counseling on medication use, and emotional support. DYPCOP students conducted the session on 'Do and Don'ts of Medicine'.
- 5. Blood Donation Camp for Thalassemia-Affected Children:** The college organizes blood donation camps to aid children battling Thalassemia, a blood disorder, with students actively setting up and contributing to the camp.

These activities demonstrate DYPCOP's commitment to developing socially responsible pharmacists who are engaged in serving and educating the community, blending pharmacy education with real-world social impact.



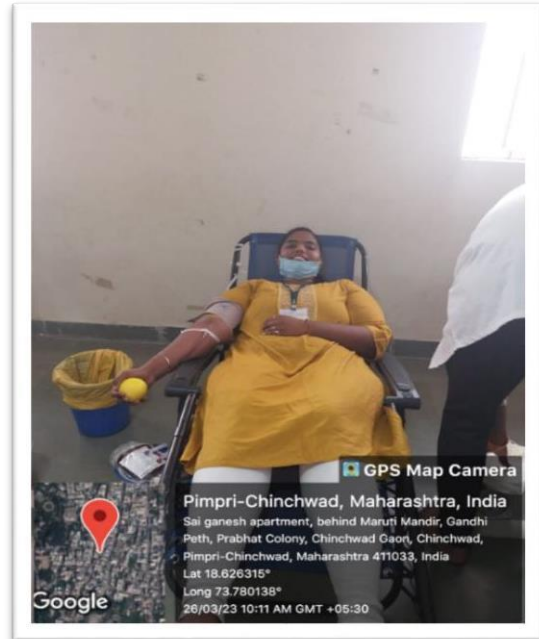
