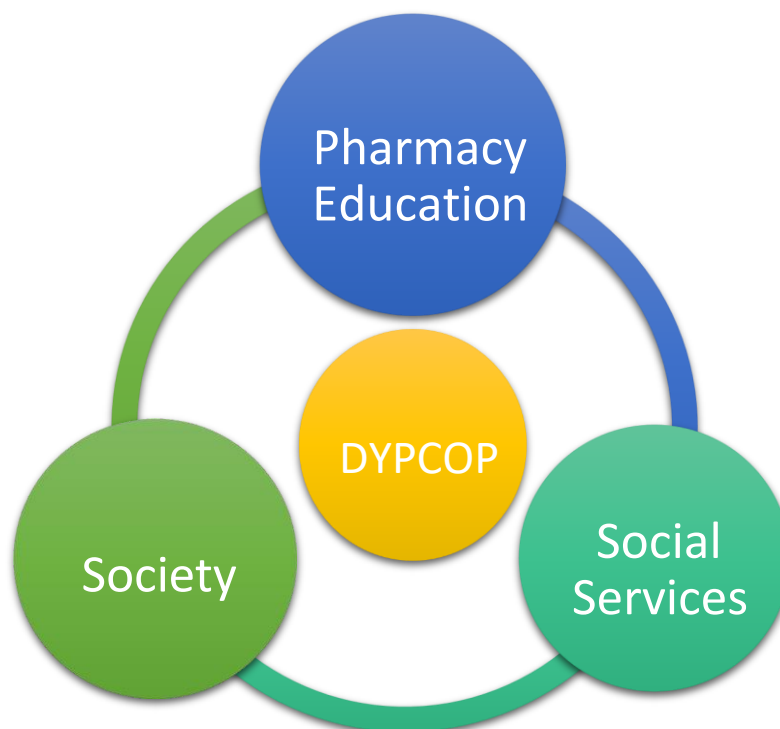

Additionally, students participate in workshops on drug safety, provide health education to underprivileged communities, and engage in environmental sustainability initiatives, all aimed at instilling the values of compassion and service in their professional development.

1. Distribution of OTC Medicine to Police and Pilgrims (War Kari): The Pandharpur Wari is not just a religious event but a cultural phenomenon that brings together people from various walks of life, united by their shared devotion to Lord Vitthoba. Pilgrims often sing devotional songs (abhangas), recite prayers, and engage in acts of devotion during the journey, which is seen as a form of pilgrimage to attain spiritual merit. Every year, DYPCOP students and faculty distribute free OTC medicines to pilgrims during the Wari, a religious pilgrimage and provide medical aid to both pilgrims and police officers involved in the event by counselling how to use OTC medicine. 2. Distribution of Books to Snehawan: Snehwan stands as a movement dedicated to children who are denied the opportunity to learn due to challenging circumstances. 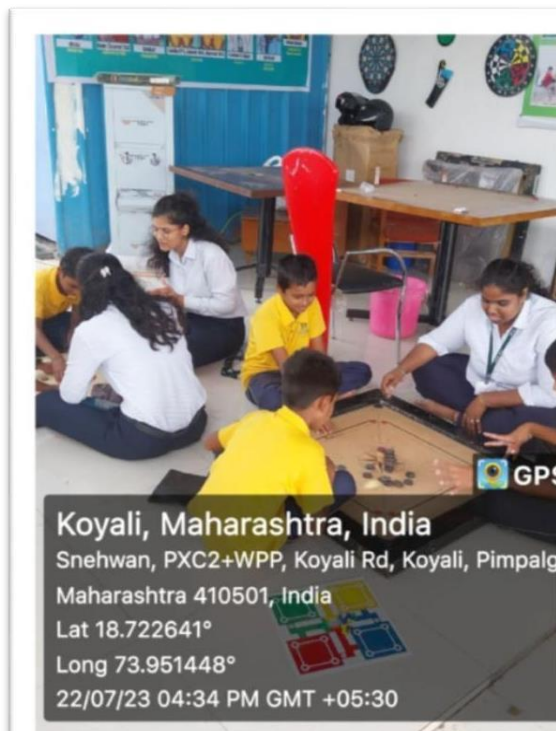
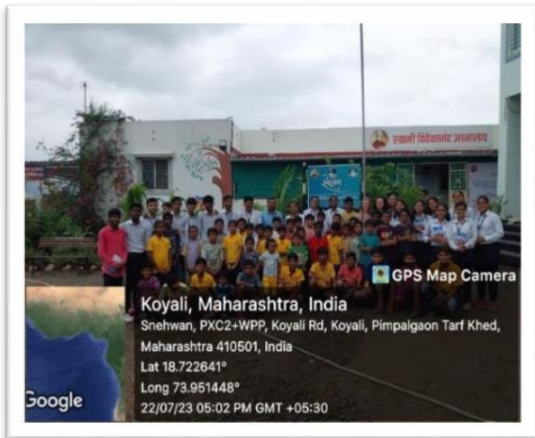
